OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject;

Grant of advances - Sixth Pay Commission recommendations-Amendment to Rules 31, 35, 38,63,58,88 of Compendium of Rules on Advances to Government Servants.

The undersigned is directed to say that in pursuance of the decision taken by the Government on the Sixth Pay Commission's recommendations relating to advances. The existing provisions of Compendium of Rules on Advances – 31,35.38,53,68,69– relating to advances for purchase of bloycle, warm clothing, table for and advances for festival and natural calamity are amended as per the amendments attached.

- 2 These orders will take affect from the date of issue. The cases where the advances have already been senctioned need not be responded.
- 3. The advance for purchase of table fan will stand discontinued. The advances for purchase of warm clothing and bicycle granted/sanctioned after issue of this order shall be treated as interest free advances.
- The rates of those advances shall be increased by 25% every time deamess allowance on revised pay bands increases by 50%
- 5 In so far as persons serving in Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, those orders issue in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India
- 6 All the Ministries/Departments are requested to bring the amendments to the notice of all its attached and subordinate offices for their information

AMENDMENTS TO COMPENDIUM OF RULES ON ADVANCES TO GOVERNMENT SERVANTS, 2005

BLCYCLE ADVANCE

RULE 31

In Rule 31:-

(u)In the opening clause indicating eligibility, for the words and figures "whose hasic pay and dearness pay taken together does not exceed Rs.7, 500 (Rupees Seven thousand five bundred) per month", the words and figures "whose grade pay does not exceed Rs.2, 800/- (Rupees I we thousand eight hundred)", shall be substituted

- (b) in proviso (i) relating to amount of advance adjussible, for the words "shall not exceed Rs.1,500 (Rupees One thousand five hundred)", the words and figures, "shall not exceed Rs.3000/- (Rupees Three thousand)", shall be substituted
- (c) Proviso (iii) relating to recovery of interest has been deleted.

WARM CLOTHING ADVANCE

RULE 35

In Rule 35 relating to undount of Worm Clothing Advance admissible, for the words "shall not exceed Rs.1,500/- (Rupees One thousand five hundred)", the words and figures, "shall not exceed Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three thousand)", shall be substituted.

Rule 38 relating to recovery of interest has been deleted.

PESTIVAL ADVANCE

RULE 53

In Rule \$3, in clause relating to eligibility for Festival Advance, for the words and figures "whose basic pay and domness pay taken together does not exceed Rs.12,450 (Rupcos Iwelve thousand four hundred and tifty) per month", the words and figures " whose Grade pay does not exceeds Rs.4800/- (Rupcos Four thousand eight hundred)", shall be substituted

RULES

In Rule 58 relating to amount of Festival Advance admissible, for the words "shall not exceed Rs.1.500 (Rupees One thousand five hundred)", the words and figures "shall not exceed Rs.3.000/- (Rupees Three thousand)", shall be substituted

NATURAL CALAMITY ADVANCE

RULE 66

In Rule 66 relating to amount of Natural Columity Advance admissible, for the words "shall not exceed Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two thousand five hundred)", the words and figures "shall not exceed Rs.5,000 (Rupees Five thousand)", shall be substituted.

Note: 5 Rule 38 A- 38P relating to Table Pan Advance deleted.

The rates of these advances shall be increased by 25% whenever the Descricts Allowence psychle on revised pay structure goes up by \$0%.
