**CIRCULAR**

#### ATHLETIC EVENTS (MEN & WOMEN)

1. **RACES:** 100, 200, 400, 800 & 1500 mtrs, Relay(100X4) and Cycle Race, 5000 mtrs.
2. **JUMPS & THROW :** Long-jump, High-jump, Shot-put, Javelin throw and Disc. Throw.

\* Basketball event has been newly included in ICAR Sports tournaments vide F.No.6(7)/2002-Cdn. dated 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2009. It should be ensured by each institute that participation in the Zonal and Final Tournaments of Basketball is allowed only to genuine players who have attained minimum standard of the event. The Total number of players would be 7(seven) Five + Two = Seven in this event and it should be adhered to strictly.

All the team events are to be conducted on **knock out basis at Zonal level and league basis in the final tournament.**

The following points may be kept in mind while conducting the tournaments:-

- i) The meeting of the Committee for drawing-up of the programme and other arrangements will be held one day in advance after the arrival of the team at the host Institute.
- ii) Expenditure of an amount of Rs.2.00 lakh will be paid by the council to the Host Institute for organizing Zonal and Inter-Zonal Tournaments.
- iii) A coach from approved sports authority recognized by the Central/State Govt. concerned if available locally may be included in the selection committee to be constituted by the each institute for selection of its contingent/players/team to ensure that the minimum standards prescribed for participating in the Zonal as well as Inter-Zonal-Final Tournaments as circulated vide Council's letter No.6-2/81-Estt.V/Genl.Admn.II dated 13<sup>th</sup> May 1983 are strictly adhered to and to ensure that no employee is allowed to participate in the tournaments/sports meet if he/she does not fulfill the minimum standard/criteria prescribed for selection for these sports/games. The number of officials accompanying the contingent may also be kept to the minimum in conformity with the instructions noted above.

It is requested to host the Zonal Tournaments/Inter-Zonal(Final) Tournament earmarked for your institute in accordance with the above mentioned circulars. The results of the Zonal Tournaments may be sent to the Host Institute of Inter-Zonal(Final) Tournament for fixing the date of Inter-Zonal(Final) Tournament. Two copies of the same may also be sent to the ICAR Hqrs. for information, compilation and necessary action.
