OFFICE ORDER

In continuation of Council's Office Order No. 1(1)/97-Plng. (Pt.IV) dated 29th March, 2001 (copy enclosed), it has been decided to append a proviso to 1.7.2(ii)(d) of the Rules and Guidelines on Training, Consultancy, Contract Research and Contract Service in ICAR System, as under:

In the matter of Honorarium of Directors (acceptable for seminars) that also pertains to consultancies and external projects, in which case they deserve to be provided such honorarium, it is hereby, provided that where funding for the training/seminar, etc. is from outside NARS, the power of sanction of such honorarium to the Director, where he is a Course Director, shall be exercised by the concerned Deputy Director-General.

This issues with the approval of competent authority.

OFFICE - ORDER
In pursuance of the recommendations made by the High Powered Advisory Committee on Implementation of Rules & Guidelines on Training, Consultancy, Contract Research and Contract Service, the Governing Body of Indian Council of Agricultural Research in its 184th meeting held on 11th September, 2000 accorded its approval to delegate the powers to sanction of honorarium to the Director of an Institute where he himself is a course Director, to Deputy Director General, administratively concerned. However, the power to sanction of honorarium to the Directors of five National Institutes viz. IARI, IVRI, NDRI, CIFE and NAARM rests with the Director General, ICAR.
2. This Officer-Order is issued in suppression of the Office-Order No.1(1)/95 - Ping (Pt. IV) Dated 25th February, 1997 with a modification of sub-clause No.(D) of Pt.(ii) of Clause No.1.7.2 of the Rules and Guidelines on Training, Consultancy, Contract Research and Contract Service in ICAR System.
3. This order will come into force with immediate effect.
