CIRCULAR

In pursuance of the decisions taken by Department of Electronics and Information Technology, communicated vide 1(2)/2014-Engg dated 10th June, 2014, the following procedure will be adopted for project implementation in NIC:

- Paid Projects will henceforth be implemented through NICSI, NIC will not directly undertake the implementation of any new Paid Projects for User Ministries/ Departments/ States and other Government Agencies. Such proposals will be examined by NIC and implemented through NICSI as the implementing Agency under NIC's supervision. Funds for such projects will be placed directly to NICSI by the project owner departments / organizations.
- ii. Alternatively, the Ministries/ Departments/ States / Organizations may consider assigning ICT related projects/ works directly to NICSI on 'Nomination' Basis', after satisfying themselves with regard to the reasonability of rates of ICT solutions and compliance with GFR provisions. Funds for such projects will be placed directly to NICSI by the project owner departments / organizations.
- III. NICSI will ensure that the tendering process, blocking process and strategic elliances fully comply with GFR and other relevant rules.
- In cases where NIC has already accepted Paid Projects on benalf of Departments / organizations, NIC will continue to work on such Paid Projects by receiving funds from the project owners. In case NIC does not have valid rates / empanelment for any goods or services required for such projects, rate contracts / empanelment of NICSI may be utilized on payment of service charge as per NICSI's procedures.
- v. In case of in-house projects of NIE, If NIC does not have valid rates / empanelment for any goods or services required for such projects, rate contracts / empanelment of NICSI may be utilized by NIC for procuring such goods and

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services through NICSI. However, NICSI will not charge any service charge to NIC for such procurements. These projects will continue to be executed under NIC's technical guidance and supervision.

- VI. The bidding process for project related activities will be conducted by NICSI, with a DDG rank officer of NIC chairing the specifications and evaluation committee(s) for ensuring compliance with GFR and other relevant rules.
- NICSI will charge "Operating Margin" uniformly from all the Ministries/
 Departments/ Organizations as per the rates approved by its Board from time to
 time. However, produrements made by NICSI for NIC's internal requirements
 would be exempted from payment of "Operating Margin". The Board of Directors
 of NICSI will issue an appropriate resolution with regard to waiving the
 "Operating Margin" for internal projects of NIC.
- Vili. Tender sections of NIC and NICST will ensure that there is no duplication of rates / empaneiment for any goods or services.

The above instructions issue with the approval of the competent authority and will come into force with immediate effect. All concerned officials should ensure implementation and compliance with the aforesaid instructions.
